WHEREAS, pollinator populations are in severe decline and require an "all hands on deck" approach to providing healthy, diverse and native habitat in the state, and raising public awareness is key to protecting pollinators; and

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado supports conservation measures the promote the protection and maintenance of pollinator habitats;
