

Native Perennial Bloom Season (How to plant for continuous bloom)

Early-Season

- Nodding onion – *Allium cernuum*
- Serviceberry – *Amelanchier alnifolia*
- Winecups – *Callirhoe involucrata*
- Sulphur flower – *Eriogonum umbellatum*
- Wallflower – *Erysimum spp.*
- Prairie smoke – *Geum triflorum*
- Blue Flax – *Linum lewisii*
- Blue mist and firecracker penstemon – *Penstemon eatorii* and *P. virens*
- Pasque flower – *Pulsatilla patens*
- Flowering fruit trees including apples, cherries, peaches and plums
- Penstemons (many native and cultivar options, check with local nursery)
- Yarrow – *Achillea millefolium*
- Boulder raspberry – *Rubus deliciosus*
- Salvias (many native and cultivar options, check with local nursery)

Mid-Season

- Lead Plant – *Amorpha canescens*
- Asters (many native and cultivar options, check with local nursery)
- Pearly everlasting – *Anaphalis margaritacea*
- Showy milkweed – *Asclepias speciosa*
- Harebells – *Campanula rotundifolia*
- Blanket flower – *Gaillardia aristata*

Late-Season

- Blue Giant Hyssop – *Agastache foeniculum*
- Rocky Mountain bee plant – *Cleome serrulata*
- Plains Coreopsis – *Coreopsis tinctoria*
- Common sunflower – *Helianthus annuus*
- Hairy False Goldenaster – *Heterotheca villosa*
- Goldenrod – *Solidago spp.*
- Rabbitbrush – *Chrysothamnus nauseosus*
- Chokecherry – *Prunus virginiana*
